This term your child will be learning:



#### Numeracy & Mathematics

Maths and Numeracy is taught through a mix of whole class, group and paired work. An active, investigative approach is encouraged across a range of topics, with cross curricular links being made. Real life contexts are used wherever possible.

Topics covered this term will include:

##### Number

- Counting forwards and backwards for positive and negative numbers
- Explain the links between a digit, its place and its value for whole numbers
- Instant recall of number facts

##### Word problems

- To solve one and two step word problems

##### Angles, symmetry and transformation

- Classify angles, measure and draw angles using a protractor
- Identify lines of symmetry

#### Expressive Arts

- Use a range of media to create work inspired from artists around the world

#### Health & Wellbeing

- Explore their rights and responsibilities
- Develop positive relationships
- Develop team work skills
- Develop gymnastic skills such as; flexibility, balance and control

#### RME

- Describe and reflect upon practices and traditions of world religions

#### Social Studies- Natural Disasters

- Explain the physical impact some natural disasters have had on earth.
- Talk about the site of a famous natural disaster
- Explain why Scotland's position on the map lessens the risk of a natural disaster

#### Literacy & English

Literacy and English is embedded throughout the curriculum. Particular areas of focus will be:

##### Reading

- Read and respond to whole class novel study using Blooms taxonomy
- Identify the author's message and key themes
- Blooms tasks to help understanding of group/ class novel
- Finding information from a variety of sources to research natural disasters as part of our interdisciplinary learning

##### Writing

- Personal and imaginative response linked to novel study and topic work
- Developing vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation
- Developing our layout and presentation skills

##### Listening and Talking

- Effective communication and active Participation in a variety of contexts
- Working co-operatively, respecting the opinions of others
- Discussions of characters, main ideas and supporting detail in the class novel
- Discussion of topical new items

#### Modern Languages

- Practise French vocabulary including simple greetings, feelings and classroom instructions

#### Technologies

- Develop skills in searching, accessing and retrieving information online
- Use technology to record a news report about a natural disaster
- Complete a natural disaster design challenge
