Numeracy & Mathematics

Maths and Numeracy is taught through a mix of whole class, group and paired work. An active, investigative approach is encouraged across a range of topics, with cross-curricular links being made. Real life contexts are used wherever possible.

Number

We have been focusing on identifying and recognising numbers up to 1,000,000 including decimal numbers.

We have been learning about decimal numbers, looking at the link between a digit, its place and its value for numbers with at least two decimal places. As well as developing our skills in adding, subtracting and multiplying decimal numbers.

Money

This term we are learning all about money, we are developing our budgeting skills and learning how to understand a bank statement.

Expressive Arts

We are using a range of media to create work inspired from artists around the world.

Health & Wellbeing

We have been exploring positive relationships, looking at what makes a good friend, how to show kindness to others and how to solve conflicts effectively.

Science – The Human Body

Primary 6 have chosen to learn about The Human Body. We are investigating some body systems and potential problems they may develop. As well as learning to make informed decisions in order to maintain our health and wellbeing.

Literacy & English

Literacy and English is embedded throughout the curriculum.

Reading

We have started reading a new whole class novel 'Holes' by Louis Sachar. We are using our higher order thinking skills to help us make sense of the text.

Writing

We have been looking at different styles of poetry. We have written our own acrostic poems, haiku's and inspired by the work of Kit Wright we have just finished writing our own poems about 'The Magic Box'.

We are continuing to work on developing our layout and presentation skills.

Listening and Talking

We are continuing to work on being effective communicators. We are developing our group work skills, focusing on working co-operatively, learning to compromise and respecting the opinions of others.

We are engaging in discussions about characters, identifying the main ideas and supporting detail in the class novel.

Modern Languages

This term in French we learning how to introduce ourselves and others, how to say our names, age and where we live.

Technologies

We have been developing skills in searching, accessing and retrieving information online.

We will be completing a variety of STEM challenges.
