<p>Story Stick – find a stick, take a walk, maybe collect interesting things to attach to it. Tell the story of your journey to someone. If you can't get outside find items around your house to go with your story stick.</p> <p>Water Painting – grab a brush, sponge or other tools and a bowl of water outside. What can you paint? What marks can you make? Try different techniques – splash, flick, smooth, swirl. (You can also draw/write in mud with sticks if you like to be messy!)</p>	<p>How long is a piece of string? (or use a shoelace) – What can you measure? What shapes can you make?</p> <p>A Number Scavenger Hunt – Become more familiar with numbers around us by collecting items from outside or inside and lining them up/counting out from one to ten. Can you find? 5 green things, 4 brown things, 3 grey things, 2 pink/red things, 1 yellow thing?</p>
Health & Wellbeing	Inter Disciplinary (Topic) and Other Learning
<p>Tipi Teddy – Can you make a simple shelter or den for teddy and friends indoors or outdoors? Share a snack and a story in your shelter with teddy and friends if you can.</p> <p>Yoga and Mindfulness – One of our favourite activities at Colinton Nursery! Easy to continue at home and take it outdoors. Create your poses inspired by nature... become a tree, frog, fish, eagle, owl. Grow like a flower and float like a butterfly. Breathe up to the sky and be mindful of the sounds, sights and smells around you.</p>	<p>Who's been framed? Gather some loose part materials indoors or out and create a portrait of someone you know. Can anyone guess who it is?</p> <p>Puddle Potential – Make your own puddle if the rain stays away! How can you study a puddle?
