Paint/crayon/feltpen the pieces. Glue/Sellotape 2 pieces together so it looks like a number 8. Flatten 2 pieces-1 for each ear and glue onto the head. Flatten 1 piece for the feet and glue onto the bottom. Add string/ribbon/wool for a wee bow round its neck. You're done. Make a simple musical instrument or instruments and keep the rhythm to your favourite songs: -cereal box and 2 spoons for a drum -2 pot lids for cymbals -empty pasta sauce jars filled with different amounts of water. -Pasta sauce lids. Stretch 1 or 2 or 3 or 4 rubber bands across and strum. -Tissue paper over a comb and hum. -Dry rice or pasta in a yogurt pot. Cover and fold down tin foil (or secure with rubber bands if you have them). Shake.....</p>
