Literacy	Numeracy & Maths
<p>Reading Spend some time reading with someone at home once a day. You can also listen to some excellent free audio books using this link: https://stories.audible.com/discovery Ebooks (see instructions on Launch pad page about making a free account to access all books) Suns – Try reading the book set by Mrs Hood on the Launch Pad Learners Page. Rainbows – Read “No Tricks, Gran!” using this link: https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/digital_books/1355.html Can you spot the words with r blends? Tornadoes – Read “The Race” using this link: https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/digital_books/1423.html Can you spot the magic e words?</p> <p>Phonics Try writing these words in as many different colours and sizes as you can: Suns – chip, chat, chin, shop, shed, shut Rainbows – drum, pram, brush, trip, drop, gran Tornadoes – hate, same, pipe, wide, code, cute Keep practising tricky words - play a game of BINGO using the block 1, 2 and 3 words Try the Sumdog ‘Tricky Words Challenge’. Can you beat your score from last week?</p> <p>Writing (RME focus) This week I would like you think of some questions to ask our school chaplain about the church (please see additional sheet on the Primary 2 page for further instructions). Daily Writing - Try and write a sentence at the end of every day to show what you have learned.</p> <p>Talking & Listening Play a game of “Simon Says” with someone at home. Will you be able to catch them out?</p>	<p>Number All: Practise counting in 10s – forwards and backwards. Can you spot the pattern? Challenge: Start at a different number each time e.g. <i>count in tens from 23 or 45.</i> Topmarks: Try the addition and subtraction sections of this game: https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/mental-maths-train Launch Pad Learners, Rectangles and Pentagons: Please complete p8 & 9 of “Total Numeracy Workbook 4” which was sent home. Octagons: Complete p1 & p2 of “Number Workbook 2” which was sent home. You can also use your Sumdog login for some numeracy practice.</p> <p>Topic Maths - Shape Watch this video about the sides and vertices of 2D shapes: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=24Uv8Cl5hvl Draw some 2D shapes. Draw over the sides with one colour of pencil and put a dot on the vertices with another colour. How many sides and vertices do they have? Have a go at the 2D shape challenge I have set for you on Sumdog.</p> <p>Inter Disciplinary (Topic) and Other Learning Space: Keep going with your moon diary. Does it look the same this week as last week? Talk to someone at home about the different shapes you see. French: Can you say your numbers from 1-20?
