<p>Reading Spend some time reading with someone at home once a day. Rainbows – Read “The Stinky Plant” using this link: https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/interactives/26345.html Is this book fiction or non-fiction? Tell someone at home about what plants need to grow. Tornadoes – Read “Who eats who?” using this link: https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/interactives/12967.html Is this book fiction or non-fiction? Tell someone at home about the learning we did in class about food chains.</p> <p>Phonics - Rhyme time! Suns – Write down as many words as you can that rhyme with cat! Rainbows – Write down as many words as you can that rhyme with need! (you can use words with ee or ea) Tornadoes – Write down as many words as you can that rhyme with boat! (Think about words that use the oa sound but also words that have magic e) Keep practising reading and writing your block 1-4 common words. Please complete the assessments I have set for you on Sumdog.</p> <p>Writing Use your rhyming words to write a rap! If you send me your rap (by the end of Thursday) I will try and perform it in our next home learning video! In the meantime, I will be practising my beatboxing... here is a video to help: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hbK5WxukBPU</p> <p>Talking & Listening Learn your rap and perform it to someone at home. Put on sunglasses and a backwards cap if you want to be extra cool!</p>	<p>Number All: Watch this video about equal groups: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=MFrwrh1gEfk Could the cookie monster have done something different? How else could he have made equal groups? Pretend to be a shop keeper. Can you give each of your customers an equal number of items? You can use pencils/sweeties/Lego or anything you have at home and your customers can be other people or teddy bears! Notice which numbers can be shared into equal groups. Can you share 10 items equally between four people? Does it always work with any number? Launch Pad Learners, Rectangles and Pentagons: Please complete p14&15 of “Total Numeracy Workbook 4” which was sent home. Octagons: Please complete p8-11 of “Total Numeracy Workbook 5” which was sent home. You have all been entered in an Edinburgh schools Sumdog competition which runs from 15th-21st May. For your scores to be on the leader board we need at least 10 people from the class to take part. It would be great to see some P2 names on there!</p> <p>Topic Maths – Time Play a game of ‘What’s the Time Mr Wolf?’ but add a special twist! Draw twelve clock faces on large pieces of paper to show the times 1-12 o’clock. When the wolf calls out the time you have pick up the correct clock face and check with them that it is right before you can move forward. Don’t forget to run when you hear, “Dinner time!”</p>
