Talk to someone about how it links to the learning you have been doing about <b>Space</b>.</p> <p><b>Phonics</b> <b>Suns</b> – see work set by Mrs Hood on the Launch Pad learners page <b>Rainbows</b> and <b>Tornadoes</b> – Print out or create your own vowel digraph flowers (see additional document) place these out on the floor and ask someone to shout out the different sounds so that you can jump onto them as quickly as you can! You could be creative with this activity and use the flowers as targets to aim items at to show that you know your sounds. <b>Keep practising reading and writing your common words until you know them without looking. Please complete the ‘Capital Letters’ assessment on Sumdog!</b></p> <p><b>Writing - Life Skills</b> Learn your home address including your post code! Write it out until you know it by heart.</p> <p><b>Talking &amp; Listening</b> Play the tea party game. In this memory game each person has to say, “At the tea party I had...” and the first person must think of something beginning with the letter <b>A</b>. The next person must repeat that item and add on one beginning with the letter <b>B</b>, for example, “At the tea party I had an <b>a</b>pple juice and a <b>b</b>anana muffin.” See how far you can get through the alphabet listing every item each time!</p>	<p><b>Number</b> <b>All: Practise doubling and halving! Roll a dice and tell someone what double the number would be</b> – remember that doubling a number is just adding it to itself! <b>Try doing the same again but with halves</b>. If you do not have a dice, you could either make your own or use the link here: <a href="https://www.online-stopwatch.com/chance-games/roll-a-dice/">https://www.online-stopwatch.com/chance-games/roll-a-dice/</a> <b>Launch Pad Learners, Rectangles</b> and <b>Pentagons</b>: Please complete p16&amp;17 of “Total Numeracy Workbook 4” which was sent home. <b>Octagons</b>: Please complete p7&amp;8 of “Number Workbook 2” which was sent home.</p> <p><b>Topic Maths – Money</b> As we are preparing for our Room to Grow Tea Party, I would like you to make a list of items that you might have at the party and give each one a price. For example, cupcake 5p, juice 2p, scone 1p. Do some role play with someone at home. Ask them to order some items from your list and add up the total amount that it would cost them. Start with small coins like 1p, 2p and 5p. <b>Challenge</b>: Use bigger coins like 10p, 20p and 50p remembering to add your tens and ones!</p>
