

# Using a timetable

I can use a simple timetable to plan events or activities.

Here is part of a train timetable				
Glasgow	9.55	10.40	11.15	11.55
Helensburgh	10.30	11.15	11.50	12.30
Crianlarich	10.55	11.40	12.15	12.55
Dalmally	11.35	-	12.55	13.35
Oban	11.50	12.05	13.10	13.50

1. How long does the first train from Glasgow take to travel to Oban?
2. How much later does the second train from Glasgow leave than the first?
3. If I catch the 10.40 train from Glasgow, how many stops are there until I reach Oban?
4. How many trains pass through Helensburgh between 11.00 and 12.00?
5. I arrive at Crianlarich at 12.00. I want to travel to Oban. I catch the next train. What time will I arrive at Oban?
6. I want to be in Oban by 13.00. What is the time of the latest train I can take from Helensburgh?
7. I want to go to Oban. Is it faster to catch the 10.30 train from Helensburgh or the 11.15 train from Helensburgh?
