For example - $3 \times 3 = 9$ $5 \times 5 = 25$ So, we say that - $3 \text{ squared} = 9$ $5 \text{ squared} = 25$ This can be written as - $3^2 = 9$ $5^2 = 25$ • Have a go at the squared number booklet on the class page. You can copy down the questions onto paper or print the booklet if you are able to. • Ask for help on Teams if you are unsure about anything. • Then, try the numeracy quiz on Teams. <p>Money</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do the money task on Sumdog. 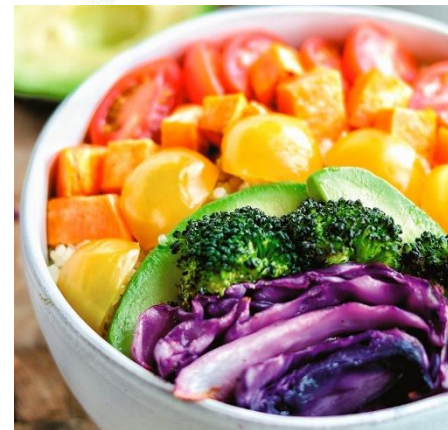

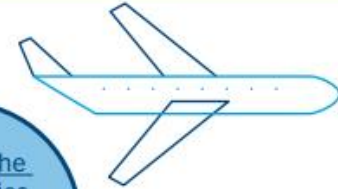
