Tornadoes – Read “Silver Foil Rocket” using this link: https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/digital_books/1373.html How many vowel digraphs and magic e words can you spot?</p> <p>Phonics Suns – see work set by Mrs Hood on the Launch Pad learners page Rainbows and Tornadoes – Choose one word from each vowel digraph flower (see additional document) and put it into a sentence. Challenge: Include more than one word from each flower and some of your common words. Keep practising reading and writing your common words! Make a matching pairs game with the words that you are finding most tricky.</p> <p>Writing – Life skills Write a letter to someone you are missing. Remember to include your address (which you learned last week) in the top right-hand corner in case they want to reply.</p> <p>Talking & Listening Interview someone at home. Think about the questions you would like to ask them, for example: <i>What is your favourite colour? What was your favourite game to play when you were younger?</i> How many new facts can you find out about people in your family?</p>	<p>Number All: Watch this video about sharing and grouping: https://open.online.clickview.co.uk/libraries/videos/6683530/division-sharing-and-grouping Sharing something between two people/putting them into two groups is the same as halving. Try the halving assessment I have set for you on Sumdog! Launch Pad Learners, Rectangles and Pentagons: Please complete p18-21 of “Total Numeracy Workbook 4” which was sent home. Octagons: Please complete p9&10 of “Number Workbook 2” which was sent home.</p> <p>Topic Maths – Money Have a look at some different coins and notes (real life or pictures from the internet). Do you know which one is which by looking at them? If not have a good look at them and learn what each one looks like. Set up a shop and do some role play with someone at home. Take turns being the shop keeper and customer, adding up totals of different items. Challenge: Work out what change the customer will need if they give you too much money! <i>Top tip: you will need to take away.</i></p> <p>Inter Disciplinary (Topic) and Other Learning Responsibility: Another one of our school values is RESPONSIBILITY. Help someone at home to cook or bake something. Show how responsible you are by carefully following instructions and remember to help wash and dry the dishes when you are finished!
