Please see separate Groupcall.</p> <p>Mindfulness - Cloud Gazing Find a safe and comfortable place outside to lie on your back. Watch the clouds above you. What shapes can you see in the clouds? How many clouds are in the sky? Look straight up in to the sky. Divide your view in to 8. How many of the 8 pieces have clouds in? What might the clouds be telling you about the weather?</p>	<p>Art/Science: Creating a Sundial. With our weather improving can you create a sundial following the instruction (see attachment)- How does it tell the time?</p> <p>Mindful listening- Go outside and listen in silence for 5 whole minutes (or as long as you are able). What could you hear? Did you notice any wildlife sounds? Or sounds made by people? Did anything surprise you?</p> <p>Alphabet Walk: Go for a walk/go into garden/go out on street. Take a sheet of paper. Write down or draw an A-Z of as many things you can see or hear or smell. Eg-hear an aeroplane, see a bee, see a cat, hear a dog, hear an echo etc. It is very tricky!!</p>
