<p><b>Health &amp; Wellbeing</b></p> <p><b>Stay active</b> – Continue to keep fit by doing some physical activity each day. Mrs Anderson</i></p> </div> <p>Remember to always complete tasks to a class standard – your work should be neat and well presented.</p>	<p><b>IDL – Let’s get outdoors! (but stay safe!)</b></p> <p>Continue to use the <b>Outdoor Learning grid</b> from last week. Choose some more activities to complete – you can do the same activity more than once! Always check with an adult before you go outside – many of the activities can be done with your family.</p> <p><b>French</b> – practise numbers in French by playing these games:-</p> <p><b>Ball games</b> – 1. Throw and catch a ball with a partner counting how many times you can do this without dropping the ball. You can also do this on your own by throwing in the air or against a wall.                      2. Use a tennis racket to bounce a ball in the air and count how many you can do without dropping the ball.</p> <p><b>Running games</b> – run laps in your garden or in the park and call out the numbers as you complete each lap – how many can you do without stopping?</p> <p><b>Bingo/Lotto</b> – have a family game of Lotto – ask your family to make a grid with 6 boxes and put a number in each box (just like we do in class) – use numbers 1-30 – then call out the numbers in French and see who crosses off all their numbers first and shouts out <b>Lotto!</b></p>
